

RECYCLING CHANGES FOR CITY OF PRESTON STARTING JULY 1

The City of Preston will no longer be able to take the recycling to Imagine the Possibilities in Maquoketa effective July 1. After looking into alternative recycling programs, City Council decided that the best option would be to contract with the <u>Clinton County Area Solid Waste</u> <u>Agency</u>. Clinton's Agency accepts co-mingled recycling, which means recycling no longer needs to be sorted by customers or City employees and the Garbage Collection Truck will be used to transport the recycling to the facility. Clinton also has a limited list on what will be accepted and how.

THE PREPARATION OF CITY RECYCLING STARTING JULY 6 REQUIREMENTS ARE:

Recycling:

Recycles should not be in a bag.

Recyclables do not need to be separated, but they must be CLEAN

Do not tie together

No oil containers

No aerosol cans

Any bin can be used for recyclables as long as it is manageable and can be lifted.

The following items are accepted:

- Tin Cans
- Plastic Food Containers #1-#7 (No Styrofoam or plastic bags/films) Must be CLEAN.
- Aluminum foil, pans, and cans
- Newspaper (Loose, not tied or in a bag and dry)
- Office Paper (Loose, not tied or in a bag and dry)
- Magazines (Loose, not tied or in a bag and dry)
- Corrugated Cardboard (must be cut down and flattened into 3 ft. by 3 ft. pieces; not tied)
- Chipboard/Fiberboard (Soda, cereal, soda boxes, etc. dry and not tied or in a bag)
